In God's care she leaves her sister, Lois Mabrey; other dear relatives, friends and her extended family at United Airlines

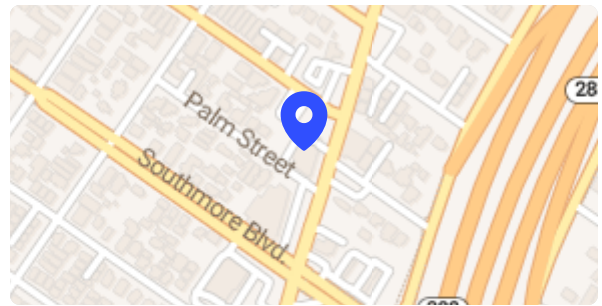

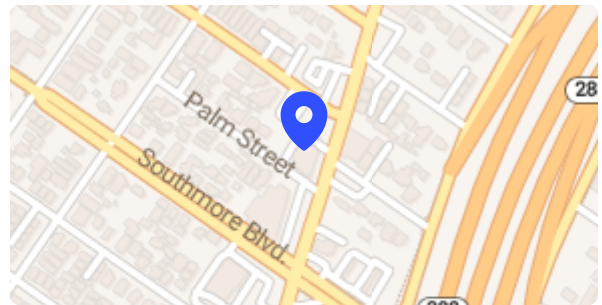
