Ms. Lisa L. Swan entered into eternal rest November 14, 2020.

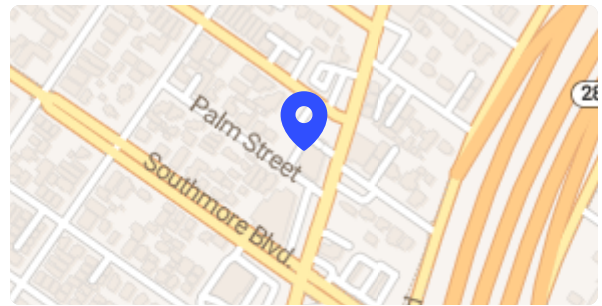
