Her visitation will be held Monday, January 11, 2021, 10:00 A.M. until 11:00 A.M.

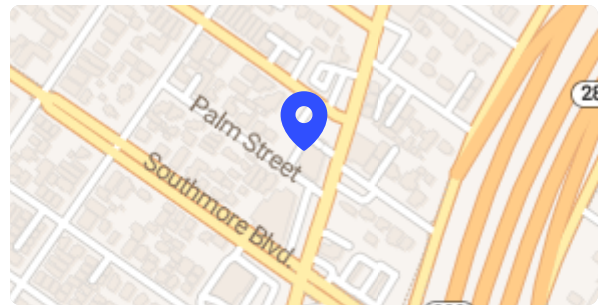
Mrs. Wade's Celebration of Life service will be private and can be accessed by live stream Monday, January 11, 2020, starting at 11:30 A.M.:
