In God's care and cherishing her memory, she leaves her loving family, loyal friends and Wheeler Avenue Baptist Church family.



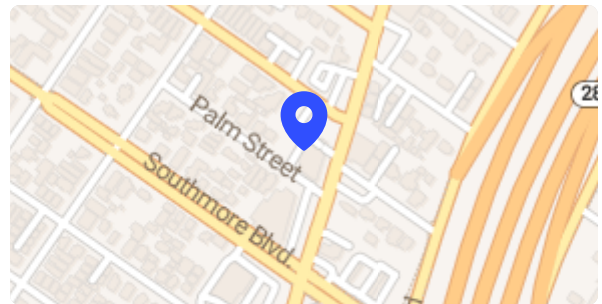

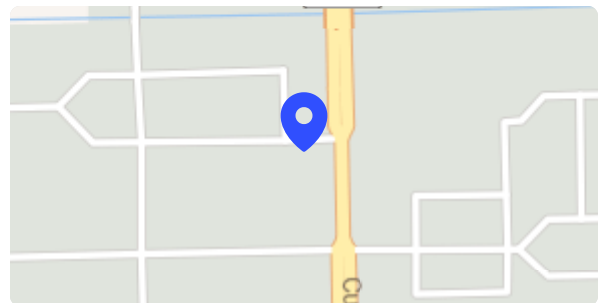
