Our beloved matriarch, Mrs. Dolores George Breaux, entered into eternal rest on April 27, 2023.

Dolores Ann George Breaux, the daughter of the late Roosevelt and Agnes Harris George, was born September 22, 1938 in New Roads, Louisiana, a small town located between the False and Mississippi Rivers in Pointe Coupée Parish. Dolores graduated from New Roads High School in 1956. After graduation, she met the love of her life, Robert Breaux, Jr.; they were married June 28, 1959.

Dolores attended Seton Hill University in Pennsylvania and the University of Louisiana-Lafayette (formerly the Southwestern Louisiana Industrial Institute). Furthermore, she received her Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education from Grambling State University.

For 46 years, Dolores had a passion for teaching young children. Her tenure as an educator in Vermilion Parish included Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic School, Kaplan Head Start, Kaplan Elementary, Maltrait Memorial Catholic School, and Cecil Picard Elementary. She expressed her creativity through her yearly classroom "themes," featuring her and her family's handmade decorations. She retired from Picard Elementary May 2012.

After retirement and along with her husband Robert, Dolores traveled the world with family and friends. They visited Turkey, the Netherlands, Tanzania, South Africa, Italy, and Ethiopia. After Robert passed, Dolores visited England, Anguilla and several destinations within the United States. Additionally, she spent time painting, going to the museum, gardening and attended musicals, plays, and concerts at the theatre.

A devout Catholic, she was a member, lector, and Adoration leader at St. Theresa of the Child Jesus Catholic Church in Abbeville, Louisiana. Eventually, she moved to Texas and lived with her two daughters until she was called home to live with our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

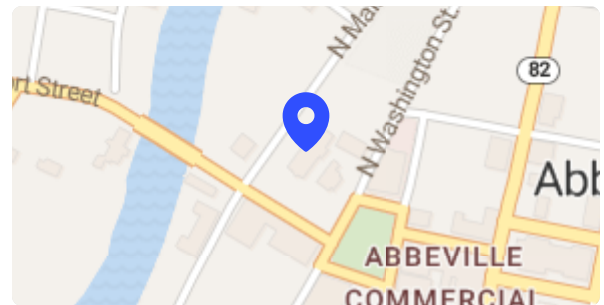

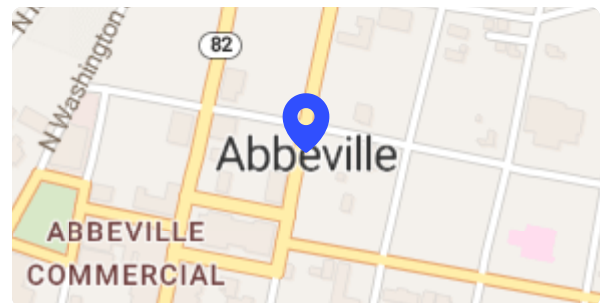

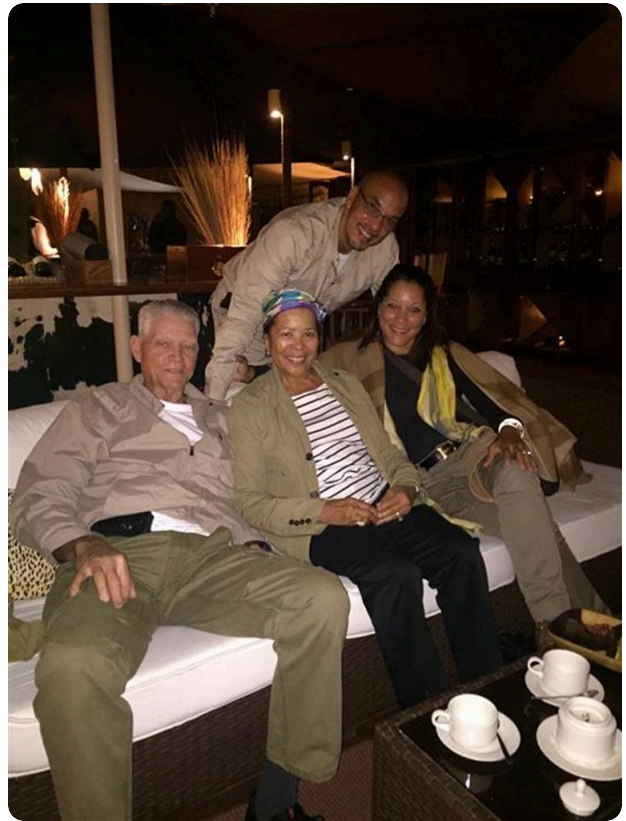
